Our hearts at EWB-USA go out to all those whose lives and homes have been affected by recent hurricanes Harvey, Irma and Katia, as well as by the recent earthquake off the shore of Mexico.

In support of making more resources available for this type of disaster response, EWB-USA has contracted with the Applied Technology Council (ATC) to offer ATC 20/45 training on October 5, in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. This training allows participants to triage buildings regarding their continued use and occupancy. **This training is NOT limited to just EWB-USA members.**

Because of the urgent need for ATC certified resources, EWB-USA is taking two actions to make this training session available to more people:

- **First, we are reducing the cost to attend the ATC 20/45 training from \$200 to \$35.** The drop in cost will in no way affect the content of the training, the materials and manuals you will receive as part of the training, nor the certifications you will receive after attending the training.
- **Second, we are offering an opportunity to attend the ATC 20/45 Training without registering for the associated EWB conference.** We understand that not all people wanting to attend the ATC 20/45 training may want to also register to attend the EWB-USA National Conference. To register for the training but not the conference, simply begin the [National Conference registration process](#) and select "Pre-Conference Workshop ONLY" in the first drop down box entitled Select Registrant Type.

We hope that these two actions on our part will persuade you to attend this training session.
